# 全球祷告日 2006

聚集在多处...

**[五旬节到了，门徒都聚集在一处。]** —— 使徒行传 2:1

## 聚集在多处

五旬节圣灵降临当日，晨光破晓之际，基督徒「**都聚集在一处**」（使徒行传 2:1）。在今年的圣灵降临节，数以百万计的基督徒将再次聚首一堂 —— 但是在多处地方。我们将相聚一起，为万国求祝福，为按照圣经的真理盼望基督得着更大的荣耀，万国得着更新转化，我们同心祷告。

## 非洲的复兴

本世纪伊始，一小群信徒聚集在南非开普敦，倾心吐意为他们的国家向神祷告。2001 年，45,000 人带着期待的心情聚集在一个球场，同心在悔改中寻求神。神给他们一个开展祷告运动的异象，这个运动很快就席卷整个非洲大陆。接下来的一年，一个球场的聚集扩展为八个球场，人数增加至 350,000 人；再过一年，人数激增至 250 万人，聚集地点急增至 130 个球场。到了 2004 年，这个祷告运动增长了十倍，膨胀至 2,200 万人，聚集地点超过 2,000 处，遍布全非洲 56 个国家！同一年，非洲邀请世界各地加入他们的祷告行列，第一个全球祷告日在 2005 年 5 月 15 日举行，估计有 2 亿人参加。

## 10 天—1 天—90 天 (10 - 1 - 90)

使徒行传是我们的楷模，基督教会产生的三步曲：10 天恒常的祷告导致五旬节圣灵降临，1 天祷告的见证让全城目睹，以及往后日子的持续祷告。因此，全球祷告日也有三部分：

## **10 天恒常祷告：2006 年 5 月 25 日至 6 月 3 日。**

从 5 月 25 日耶稣升天节（即圣灵降临节之前 10 天）开始，数以百万计的基督徒，将仿效基督的门徒在五旬节圣灵降临日之前所做的，昼夜祷告 10 天。

## **1 天全球祷告日：2006 年 6 月 4 日。**

在圣灵降临节主日，来自世界各地的基督徒，将分别于家中、小型聚会场所、球场或露天广场，聚集一起祷告。电视、电台、互联网将转播祷告会的情况，使我们的祷告连结得更紧密。

## **90 天社区祝福：2006 年 6 月 5 日至 9 月 2 日。**

正如在首个五旬节圣灵降临之后，更新转化了的基督徒因着祷告蒙应允，便把自己献给神，成为神流通的管子，透过他们使他们身处的社区得着更新转化。全球祷告日期望牧者、教会、宣教机构、商业领袖等，能在本地组成联盟，继续为身处的社区得着实际的更新转化而努力。

## **为什么祈求圣灵更大的降临？**

—— *为了基督的荣耀和万国的更新转化*

在耶稣和门徒共处的最后一天，祂嘱咐他们留在耶路撒冷，等候「父所应许的」。耶稣被接升天之后，门徒聚集一起，谨遵耶稣的吩咐，等候父所应许的。然而，他们的祷告不是单单为了个人灵命的长进。在神为了实现祂的应许所做的一切事情中，领受神的圣灵是起始点。门徒热切地、满有盼望地祷告，祈求神成就祂的应许，叫祂的国度在全地上实现。

## **热切盼望神的应许**

在五旬节过后的日子，门徒继续向神祷告。当我们读他们的祷文，聆听他们从心里倾吐的祷告，我们可以知道他们在那十天当中是怎样祷告的。他们的祷告远远超越了眼前所关心的事物和个人难题，

他们的祷告源自圣经经文。基督用更新了的异象点燃他们的盼望，让他们看到祂国度的能力和爱在万族万民中扩展。

## 走向更大的五旬节的应许

正如他们对五旬节的奇事感到惊讶，在五旬节之后，他们继续为基督的荣耀和祂旨意的成就祷告。假如他们今天跟我们在一起，相信他们会祈求神以更伟大的方法，去把祂的圣灵浇灌出来，并大大使用祂的子民。

## 十天同心合意的祷告

世界各地的信徒，从 5 月 25 日（星期四）耶稣升天节开始，一直持续到 6 月 3 日（星期六），将会以各种方法组织起来，昼夜一同祷告。初期门徒「**同心合意的恒切祷告**」（使徒行传 1:14），成为我们的榜样和激励。我们期望，在耶稣升天节与圣灵降临节之间的十天，每一个时区每一个小时，都充满信徒的祷告。下面的指引会翻译成多种语言，以致世界各地数以百万计的信徒，在这十天的祷告中，会有相同的圣经起始点。你不会独自一人祷告的。

## 基督一再呼吁祂的教会同心祷告

震动世界的大灾难驱使我们去祷告；更甚者，神精彩美好的应许，应该推动我们迫切热烈地发出祷告。现在是时候了，神的子民要恒常地聚集在一起，在祷告中合一。我们把自己分别出来，用十天的时间寻求神，并以五旬节的高潮作结，正如耶稣初期的门徒所做的，有什么方法比这更美好呢？

# 十天恒常祷告

5月25日至6月3日(10-1-90)

## 如何使用本祷告指引

### 1. 祷告要以圣经为根据

思想使徒行传中的经文，怎样为每天的祷告重点提供基础，使我们能放胆祷告。例如：第六天的经文：**「因为这应许是给你们和你们的儿女……」**（使徒行传 2:39），就为神计划为世界各地的年青人所做的，提供了支持和联合祷告的重点。请你浏览 [www.waymakers.org/tenday](http://www.waymakers.org/tenday)，查看每天经文的解释和连结，你会找到更详细的资料，知道每天的精选经文怎样引导你祷告，并使联合的祷告更有能力。

### 2. 祷告要具体

每天的主题只是提供一个起点，请你做一些调查，了解你身处社区的需要，列出相应具体的祷告要点。

## 聚集一起作特别祷告的方法

### 1. 找出具创意的聚集方式

数以百万计的基督徒会以非凡的方式一起祷告。很多人会组成祷告炼，或计划长时间的聚会，使十天中每一天的 24 小时都充满祷告。在这十天当中，找出具创意的方法，与其它人相聚在一起，作长时间的祷告。你可以：

- 一家人一起祷告，或在家中举行小组祷告聚会。
- 开放教会的小型聚会给其它人参加，或计划特别的祷告时段。
- 在会众中组织特别的祷告音乐会。
- 在十天中，禁食一天或多天，甚至禁食十天。
- 在电话中与朋友一起祷告，或用电话会议祷告。

## 2. 联合一致地祷告

在第一个的楼房祷告会中，门徒「同心合意」地祷告。你可以简短的话语，为相似的主题，与其它人一起同心地祷告，奋力向前。

## 3. 用不同的语言祷告

## 4. 注意神可能会引导你的方法

当你为你的社区祷告时，神可能会感动你和其它人，以特别的方法，使你成为祷告蒙应允的部分答案。

# 第一天

5月25日（星期四）

## 基督的国度

——为基督国度的更新转化能力祷告

**[...讲说神国的事。耶稣和他们聚集的时候，嘱咐他们说：『不要离开耶路撒冷，要等候父所应许的，就是你们听见我说过...』]**——使徒行传 1:3-4

## 为祂的教会

- 求神使我们火热爱主，忠于基督这位万王之王、万有之主。
- 求神感动我们，使我们在盼望中竭力追求主所应许的一切。
- 尽管神的子民分散各地，求神使他们藉基督再次聚集并顺服祂。

## 为我们的世界

- 求神感动信徒的心，恒切祷告，祈求突破，叫神国度的祝福临到那些面对重重困难的地方。
- 求神让千千万万在我们城市中的人，经历基督慈爱的美善和荣耀，藉此把持久的转化带进整个社区中。

# 第二天

## 5月26日（星期五）

### 联合祷告运动

——为联合祷告运动能持续下去祷告

*[这些人...都同心合意地恒切祷告。]*——使徒行传 1:14

#### 为祂的教会

- 求圣灵赐下代祷的灵，使我们心存期待、怜悯和盼望，持续地为神国度的应许得以成就祷告。
- 求神将我们联合起来，「同心合意」地祷告；求神赐我们能力和热心，为基督得荣耀和世人得怜悯祷告。

#### 为我的世界

- 求神感动在我们社区的人们去呼求神，寻求祂的帮助。
- 求神使社区的领袖仰望祂，在祷告中祈求祂的帮助。
- 愿贫穷、年幼和社会边缘群体，因祷告得蒙应允而献上赞美，叫神得着荣耀。

# 第三天

## 5月27日（星期六）

### 基督的灵

—— 为神浇灌祂的灵在众人身上祷告

*[神说：在末后的日子，我要将我的灵浇灌凡有血气的.....]*

—— 使徒行传 2:17

### 为祂的教会

- 求神的灵带着能力和生命临到基督徒。
- 求神的灵赐教会能力，在世上成为见证基督的仆人。

### 为我的世界

- 求神的灵唤醒我们国家和社区里所有人，使他们能听见祂的声音，看见祂的作为。
- 求神再次把祂的圣灵浇灌下来，使每一个人都能听见祂的声音，看见祂的作为（使徒行传 2:33）。

# 第四天

## 5月28日（星期日）

### 悔改

——为多人离恶从善，得着在基督里的新生命祷告

**[所以，你们当悔改归正，使你们的罪得以涂抹，这样，那安舒的日子就必从主面前来到。]**——使徒行传 3:19

### 为祂的教会

- 求神叫我们看见自己的罪，公开承认我们怎样叫神忧伤。
- 求神感动我们，使我们降伏在神的怜悯之下，以致我们的罪 **「得以涂抹」**（使徒行传 3:19）。
- 求神靠近祂的百姓，揭示祂的同在，使 **「那安舒的日子」**（使徒行传 3:19）来到，好像雨水降临干旱之地一样。

### 为我的世界

- 求神使基督徒领先转离 **「罪恶」**（使徒行传 3:26），以致大规模的悔改运动席卷整个社区。
- 愿千千万万的人遇见基督赦免的大爱，以致他们离弃罪恶跟从祂，得享救恩之乐。

# 第五天

## 5月29日（星期一）

### 基督的平安

——为人际关系得以更新转化祷告

*[信的人都在一处，凡物公用；并且卖了田产，家业，照各人所需用的分给各人。他们天天同心合意恒切地在殿里，且在家中擘饼，存着欢喜、诚实的心用饭，赞美神，得众民的喜爱。...]——使徒行传 2:44-47*

### 为祂的教会

- 求神使教会复和，除掉教会之间的分歧和敌视。
- 求神使祂的子民转离贪婪和世俗的情欲，变成十分慷慨的人。
- 求神使基督徒之间的关系充满爱、喜乐和欢欣。
- 求神赐教会在各社区中蒙恩。

### 为我的世界

- 求神借着祂子民生命的更新，让全世界经历祂所赐的平安。
- 求神医治家庭中和邻舍间的破碎关系。
- 求神介入战争，遏止邪恶的灵界势力和恐怖主义，保护困苦人的生命。
- 求神使用基督徒帮助人脱离极端贫穷的压制。（估计有超过十亿人每天收入少于一美元，在贫困之中挣扎求存。）

# 第六天

## 5月30日（星期二）

### 新一代

——为神的旨意成就在家庭和儿童中祷告

*[因为这应许是给你们和你们的儿女...]* —— 使徒行传 2:39

### 为祂的教会

- 求主基督巩固婚姻关系和家庭制度。
- 愿儿童和青少年从小就认识并跟随基督，专心致志服侍祂。
- 求神叫年青领袖得着赏识，并能带领教会倍增。  
(使徒行传 6:3-7)

### 为我的世界

- 求神怜悯全球 1.2 亿没有机会接受教育的儿童，使他们能得到教育机会。
- 求神怜悯数以百万计因战争或艾滋病失去父母的孤儿，叫祂的子民能因着神的爱，做到幼吾幼以及人之幼。（以目前的感染速度，预计到了 2010 年，全球将有 2,500 万儿童的父母死于艾滋病。）
- 求神赐能力给新一代，在全地实现祂的应许。

# 第七天

## 5月31日（星期三）

### 神的呼召

——为万国得听见神的声音祷告

**[.....并一切在远方的人，就是主我们神所召来的。]**

——使徒行传 2:39

### 为祂的教会

- 求圣灵充满基督徒，使他们能有智慧并放胆传讲神的话语。
- 求神使祂的话语在各族、各民和各语言中被传扬。  
(使徒行传 1:8)

### 为我的世界

- 求神使世人能透过他们自己的语言和文化方式，听闻祂 **「大能的作为」**（使徒行传 2:11）。
- 求神怜悯尚未有自己语言圣经的 3,000 个群体，愿圣经早日翻译成他们的语言。
- 很多未认识神的人居住在没有活泼增长教会的地区，求神怜悯千千万万的未得之民，叫他们能跟随基督。
- 求神召来并拯救许多求告祂名的人。（使徒行传 2:39, 21）

# 第八天

## 6月1日（星期四）

### 主耶稣的荣耀

——为祂的子民有忠诚和勇气荣耀主名祷告

*[他们.....心里欢喜，因被算是配为这名受辱。]*

——使徒行传 5:41

### 为祂的教会

- 求神帮助因耶稣的名被敌挡的人，使他们彰显出耶稣的温柔和刚强。（使徒行传 4:13）
- 求神刚强为基督的名受苦的信徒，使他们满有喜乐和信心。
- 求神在敌挡祂的地区中行奇事，并因此得荣耀。（使徒行传 4:21）

### 为我的世界

- 求神赐福我们的政府和众领袖。
- 求神赐智慧给那些敌挡基督的领袖（使徒行传 4:25-27），使他们不再「攻击神」（使徒行传 5:39）。

# 第九天

## 6月2日（星期五）

### 基督的医治

——为基督赐下实质的医治祷告

*[.....伸出你的手来医治疾病，并且使神迹奇事因着你圣仆耶稣的名行出来。]*——使徒行传 4:30

### 为祂的教会

- 求神在患病的人中间施行神迹，医治他们。
- 求神赐基督徒坚毅怜悯的心，致力消除疾病。
- 求神使信徒能够在有极大需要的地方，提供基本的医疗服务。

### 为我的世界

- 求神在我们这一代消灭艾滋病。（现时，每月有 250,000 个年轻人受感染。）
- 求神赐基本的医疗服务给最需要的人。（每天，全球有超过 30,000 名儿童死于可预防的疾病。）

# 第十天

## 6月3日（星期六）

### 基督的祝福

——为神应许的祝福临到万民祷告

**[（神）对亚伯拉罕说：『地上万族都要因你的后裔得福。』]**

——使徒行传 3:25

### 为祂的教会

- 求神使基督徒生活心存盼望，期待古老应许的祝福得以实现，看见国家社区被神更新转化。
- 求神叫众教会能同心通力合作，与神同工，使生命、城市、国家得着改变。

### 为我的世界

- 求神的公义公平转化商业和政治运作的方式，正本清源，纠正社会的歪风，使人们脱离贪污腐败的咒诅。
- 求基督国度的和平，改变城市和国家的管治方式。
- 求基督生命中的喜乐，丰丰富富地临到地上每一个族群。

# *A Global Day of Prayer*

*All together...in many places*

*“When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place.” – Acts 2:1*

## **All together in many places.**

As dawn broke on the first Pentecost, Christians were gathered “all together in one place” (Acts 2:1). On Pentecost, many millions of Christians will again be all together – but in many places. We’ll join together in prayers of blessing for the nations, praying in one accord for the biblical hope of Christ’s greater glory and the transformation of all nations.

## **Arising from Africa.**

At the dawn of this century, a small band of believers gathered in Cape Town, South Africa, pouring out their hearts to God for their nation. A stadium full of 45,000 expectant people gathered in 2001 to seek God in repentance. God gave them a vision for a prayer movement that would soon sweep the continent of Africa. The next year that one gathering expanded to eight stadiums with 350,000 people, then jumped the following year to a staggering 2.5 million gathered in 130 stadiums. In 2004, the movement multiplied ten-fold, swelling to 22 million people gathered at more than 2,000 sites in every one of the 56 countries of Africa! That same year Africa invited the world to join them in the first Global Day for Prayer, which drew together an estimated 200 million people on May 15th, 2005.

## **10 Days - 1 Day - 90 Days (10 - 1 - 90)**

With the Book of Acts as a model, we can find inspiration in the three parts to the birth of the Church: ten days of constant prayer leading to Pentecost, one day of prayer witnessed by the whole city, and days of blessing that followed. For these reasons, the Global Day of Prayer has three parts:

## **Ten days of constant prayer: May 25-June 3, 2006.**

On Ascension Day, May 25th, millions of Christians will find ways to begin praying night and day throughout the ten days leading to Pentecost, following the pattern of Christ’s followers before the first Pentecost.

## **The Global Day of Prayer: June 4, 2006.**

On Pentecost Sunday, Christians in almost every country will assemble to pray, many in homes and other public venues, many more in stadiums and open squares. Television, radio and internet will help to connect and align our prayers even more.

## **Ninety days of blessing: June 5 - September 2, 2006.**

As in the first Pentecost, transformed Christians transform their communities, offering themselves to God as the instruments through which their prayers are answered. The Global Day of Prayer anticipates the forming or furthering of local alliances among pastors, congregations, mission agencies, business leaders, to bring practical, transformational blessing to their communities.

## **Why pray toward a greater Pentecost?**

*...For the Glory of Christ and the Transformation of Nations*

On the last day He was with them, Jesus told His followers to stay in Jerusalem and to wait for "the promise of the Father." After Jesus was received into heaven, they gathered to do exactly what Jesus had told them: to wait for the promise of the Father. But they were praying for much more than a personal spiritual enrichment. Receiving God's Spirit was the beginning of all that God would do to finish everything He promised. They prayed in fervent, hope-filled passion for God to fulfill His promises regarding His kingdom all over the earth.

## **Hope-filled passion for God's promises.**

As we read their prayers and listen to what poured out from their hearts in the days that followed Pentecost, we can get an idea of how they prayed during those ten days. They were praying far beyond their immediate concerns and personal problems. Their prayers sprang from the written Word of God. Christ Himself had ignited their hope with a renewed vision of the advance of the love and power of His kingdom among all peoples.

## **Toward the promise of a greater Pentecost.**

As amazed as they were at the wonders of Pentecost, they kept on praying after Pentecost for Christ's glory and the fulfillment of His purpose. If they were with us today, they would likely be praying for God to pour out His Spirit and use His people in even greater ways.

## **Ten days uniting in prayer.**

Beginning on Ascension Day, Thursday, May 25th, and continuing until Saturday, June 3rd, believers around the world will be organizing ways to pray together night and day. Inspired by the example of the first followers who “joined together constantly” in prayer (Acts 1:14), we expect that the ten days between the time of the ascent of Jesus and the descent of His Spirit will be filled with believers praying around the clock and across all time zones. The following prayer guide is being translated in many languages so that millions of people around the world will have the same biblical beginning points as they pray through these ten days. You won’t be praying alone.

### **Christ again calls His church to unite in prayer.**

The great troubles that shake our world compel us to pray. But even more, the tremendous promises of God should move us to pray with urgency and desire. It is time for God’s people to gather again in persistent, united prayer. What better way is there than to consecrate ourselves to seek God for ten days, as Jesus’ first followers did, culminating on the day of Pentecost?

# *Ten Days of Constant Prayer*

*25 May - 3 June (10 - 1 - 90)*

## **How to Use this Prayer Guide**

### **1. Ground your prayers in Scripture.**

Consider how the verses from the book of Acts provide a basis to pray with boldness for the daily prayer emphasis. For example, on Day 5, the scripture, “the promise is for you and your children...” gives support and focus for united prayer for what God intends to bring forth for young people all over the world. Check the biblical exposition and links for each day at [www.waymakers.org/tenday](http://www.waymakers.org/tenday). You’ll find more details about how each day’s scripture selection can guide and empower united prayer.

### **2. Make the prayers specific.**

The daily topics provide a starting point. Do some research and make a list of specific prayer points which pertain to the people of your community.

## **Ways to Gather in Extraordinary Prayer**

### **1. Find creative ways to gather.**

Millions of Christians will be praying together in extraordinary ways. Many will form prayer chains or plan prolonged meetings which will fill 24 hours a day for ten days. Find creative ways during this ten-day period to gather with others to pray for extended times.

- Pray together as families or any small group meeting in your home.
- Leave church doors open for small gatherings, or plan special prayer times.
- Organize special concerts of prayer among congregations.
- Fast for one or more or all of the ten days.
- Pray over the telephone with a friend or set up a conference call to pray.

- Many will pray around the clock through the ten days. Find practical ideas about 24-hour prayer at [www.24-7prayer.com](http://www.24-7prayer.com), [xtremepayer.com](http://xtremepayer.com) and [www.globaldayofprayer.com/prayer.asp](http://www.globaldayofprayer.com/prayer.asp).

## **2. Pray unitedly.**

At the first upper-room prayer meeting, they prayed with “one mind” or “one accord.” Pray in agreement with others by offering brief prayers that keep pressing forward on similar themes.

## **3. Pray with different languages.**

Many millions of Christians the world over will be praying these prayers. See [www.globaldayofprayer.com](http://www.globaldayofprayer.com) for translations available in a number of other languages.

## **4. Watch for ways God may guide you.**

As you pray for your community, God may impress you and others with specific ways that He can use you to become part of the answer to your prayers.

# *Day ONE*

## *May 25 Thursday*

### **THE KINGDOM OF CHRIST**

*...For the transforming power of Christ's kingdom*

*"...and speaking of the things concerning the kingdom of God. Gathering them together, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised, 'Which,' He said, 'you heard of from Me...'" — Acts 1:3-4 (NASB)*

#### **For His Church**

- For our hearts to blaze with love and loyalty to Christ as King and Lord of all.
- To be moved in hope so that we actively pursue all that He has promised.
- That however God's people may have been scattered and divided, we would be gathered again by Christ to obey Him.

#### **For Our World**

- For Christ to position believers in cities where breakthrough of blessing has not yet happened. Pray that they would patiently pursue God's promise of the blessing of His kingdom in those difficult places.
- For the goodness and glory of Christ's kingly love to be experienced by the masses in our cities, bringing lasting transformation throughout entire communities.

# *Day TWO*

## *May 26 Friday*

### **UNITED PRAYER**

*...For sustained movements of united prayer*

*“These all with one mind were continually devoting themselves to prayer...” — Acts 1:14 (NASB)*

#### **For His Church**

- That God’s Spirit would give us a spirit of expectant intercession, compassion and hope to pray persistently for promises of His kingdom to be fulfilled.
- That God would unite us in prayer with “one mind,” empowering us to pray together with passion for Christ’s glory and compassion for the world.

#### **For Our World**

- That people throughout our communities would be moved to call out to God for His help as never before.
- That the leaders of our community would look to God for His help in prayer.
- That God would be glorified by the praises of the poor, the young, and the marginalized as He answers their prayers.

# *Day Three*

## *May 27 Saturday*

### **THE SPIRIT OF CHRIST**

*...For God to pour out His Spirit upon all*

*“‘In the last days,’ God says, ‘I will pour out my Spirit on all people...’” – Acts 2:17*

#### **For His Church**

- For the Spirit of God to come upon Christians in powerful, life-giving ways.
- For the Church to be empowered by His Spirit to be Christ’s witnessing servants in the world.

#### **For Our World**

- That the Spirit of God would awaken people throughout our community and nation to hear His voice and to see His works.
- That once again, God would pour out from heaven that which everyone can “see and hear” (Acts 2:33).

# *Day Four*

## *May 28 Sunday*

### **REPENTANCE**

*...For many to turn from sin to new life in Christ*

*“Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord.”*

*— Acts 3:19*

#### **For His Church**

- That we would recognize our sin and openly confess how we have grieved God.
- That we would be moved to fall upon God’s mercy for our sin to “be wiped out” (Acts 3:19).
- That God would draw near to His people, revealing His presence, bringing “times of refreshing” (Acts 3:19) like rain on dry ground.

#### **For Our World**

- That Christians would be the first to turn “from their wicked ways” (Acts 3:26) so that massive movements of repentance would sweep through whole communities.
- For Christ to encounter millions of people with His forgiving love, so that they turn from their sin to the joy of following Him.

# *Day Five*

## *May 29 Monday*

### **THE PEACE OF CHRIST**

*...For relationships to be transformed*

*“All the believers were together and had everything in common. Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need... They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people...” — Acts 2:44-47*

#### **For His Church**

- For reconciliation among churches, removing divisions and hostilities.
- For God’s people to turn away from greed and worldly desires and to become more generous than ever before.
- For relationships among Christians to be marked by love, joy and gladness of heart.
- For churches to enjoy renewed favour in every community.

#### **For Our World**

- For God to bring outbreaks of Christ’s peace all over the world through the changed lives of His people.
- For God to heal broken relationships in homes and neighbourhoods.
- For God to intervene in wars, restraining spiritual forces of evil, subduing terrorism, and protecting the lives of those afflicted.
- For God to use Christians to help lift people out of the oppression of extreme poverty. It is estimated that over a billion people struggle to survive on less than one dollar a day.

# *Day Six*

## *May 30 Tuesday*

### **THE COMING GENERATION**

*...For God's purpose for families and children*

*"For the promise is for you and your children..."*

*— Acts 2:39 (NASB)*

#### **For His Church**

- For marriages and homes to be strengthened by Christ.
- For children and youth to follow Christ early in life, serving Him with extreme devotion.
- That young leaders would be recognized and released to lead the church to grow in multiplying ways (Acts 6:3-7).

#### **For Our World**

- For God to send educators to the 120 million children worldwide who lack access to education.
- For God to use His people to extend His fatherly love to millions of children orphaned by wars and the HIV/AIDS epidemic. At the current rate of infection 25 million children will lose their parents to AIDS in the next four years.
- For God to empower the coming generation to fulfil His promises throughout the earth.

# *Day Seven*

## *May 31 Wednesday*

### **THE CALL OF GOD**

*...For the nations to hear the voice of God*

*"...and for all who are far off, as many as the Lord our God will call to Himself." — Acts 2:39 (NASB)*

#### **For His Church**

- For Christians to be filled with the Spirit in order to communicate the word of God boldly and wisely.
- For the word of God to be proclaimed to people of every language, tribe and nation (Acts 1:8).

#### **For Our World**

- That the world would hear of the "mighty deeds of God" in the words of their own language and the ways of their own culture (Acts 2:11).
- For the Bible to be translated for the 3,000 people groups without even one verse in their language.
- For Christ to be followed among the thousands of unreached people groups who lack vital, growing, multiplying churches.
- That God would call to Himself many (Acts 2:39) who would call on Him to be saved (Acts 2:21).

## *June 1 Thursday*

### **THE GLORY OF JESUS**

*...In the faithful courage of His people*

*"...rejoicing because they had been counted worthy of suffering disgrace for the Name." — Acts 5:41*

#### **For His Church**

- For God to be glorified by His great deeds in places where He has been opposed (Acts 4:21).

- That some government leaders who are opposing Christ (Acts 4:25-27) would be blessed with wisdom to be found not "fighting against God" (Acts 5:39).

*“Stretch out Your hand to heal and perform miraculous signs and wonders through the name of Your Holy Servant Jesus.”*

*— Acts 4:30*

- That God would move among the sick to bring miraculous healing (Acts 5:14-16).
- For Christians to act with persistent compassion to work for the eradication of diseases.
- For Christians to be engaged in providing basic healthcare where needs are great.

#### **For Our World**

- For the end of HIV/AIDS in our generation. At this time 250,000 young people are infected every month.
- For basic healthcare to those most needy. Over 30,000 children die daily worldwide from preventable diseases.

## *June 3 Saturday*

### **THE BLESSING OF CHRIST**

*...For promised blessing among all peoples*

*“He said to Abraham, ‘Through your offspring all peoples on earth will be blessed.’” — Acts 3:25*

#### **For His Church**

- For Christians to live with expectancy for the ancient promise of blessing to be fulfilled, seeing transformation of their communities and countries.
- For churches to work together in unity, co-working with God to change lives, cities and nations.

#### **For Our World**

- For the righteousness and justice of God to transform the ways of commerce and politics, cleansing whole societies from the curse of corruption.
- For the peace of Christ’s kingdom to change the way cities and nations are governed.
- For the joy of Christ’s life to flourish throughout every people group on earth.
