聚集在多處...

[五旬節到了，門徒都聚集在一處。]——使徒行傳 2:1

聚集在多處

五旬節聖靈降臨當日，晨光破曉之際，基督徒「**都聚集在一處**」（使徒行傳 2:1）。在今年的聖靈降臨節，數以百萬計的基督徒將再次聚首一堂——但是在多處地方。我們將相聚一起，為萬國求祝福，為按照聖經的真理盼望基督得著更大的榮耀，萬國得著更新轉化，我們同心禱告。

非洲的復興

本世紀伊始，一小群信徒聚集在南非開普敦，傾心吐意為他們的國家向神禱告。2001年，45,000人帶著期待的心情聚集在一個球場，同心在悔改中尋求神。神給他們一個開展禱告運動的異象，這個運動很快就席捲整個非洲大陸。接下來的一年，一個球場的聚集擴展為八個球場，人數增加至350,000人；再過一年，人數激增至250萬人，聚集地點急增至130個球場。到了2004年，這個禱告運動增長了十倍，膨脹至2,200萬人，聚集地點超過2,000處，遍佈全非洲56個國家！同一年，非洲邀請世界各地加入他們的禱告行列，第一個全球禱告日在2005年5月15日舉行，估計有2億人參加。

10天—1天—90天 (10 - 1 - 90)

使徒行傳是我們的楷模，基督教會產生的三部曲：10天恆常的禱告導致五旬節聖靈降臨，1天禱告的見證讓全城目睹，以及往後日子的持續禱告。因此，全球禱告日也有三部分：

10 天恆常禱告：2006 年 5 月 25 日至 6 月 3 日。

從 5 月 25 日耶穌升天節（即聖靈降臨節之前 10 天）開始，數以百萬計的基督徒，將仿效基督的門徒在五旬節聖靈降臨日之前所做的，晝夜禱告 10 天。

1 天全球禱告日：2006 年 6 月 4 日。

在聖靈降臨節主日，來自世界各地的基督徒，將分別於家中、小型聚會場所、球場或露天廣場，聚集一起禱告。電視、電台、互聯網將轉播禱告會的情況，使我們的禱告連結得更緊密。

90 天社區祝福：2006 年 6 月 5 日至 9 月 2 日。

正如在首個五旬節聖靈降臨之後，更新轉化了的基督徒因著禱告蒙應允，便把自己獻給神，成為神流通的管子，透過他們使他們身處的社區得著更新轉化。全球禱告日期望牧者、教會、宣教機構、商業領袖等，能在本地組成聯盟，繼續為身處的社區得著實際的更新轉化而努力。

為什麼祈求聖靈更大的降臨？

—— 為了基督的榮耀和萬國的更新轉化

在耶穌和門徒共處的最後一天，祂囑咐他們留在耶路撒冷，等候「父所應許的」。耶穌被接升天之後，門徒聚集一起，謹遵耶穌的吩咐，等候父所應許的。然而，他們的禱告不是單單為了個人靈命的長進。在神為了實現祂的應許所做的一切事情中，領受神的聖靈是起始點。門徒熱切地、滿有盼望地禱告，祈求神成就祂的應許，叫祂的國度在全地上實現。

熱切盼望神的應許

在五旬節過後的日子，門徒繼續向神禱告。當我們讀他們的禱文，聆聽他們從心裡傾吐的禱告，我們可以知道他們在那十天當中是怎樣禱告的。他們的禱告遠遠超越了眼前所關心的事物和個人難題，

他們的禱告源自聖經經文。基督用更新了的異象點燃他們的盼望，讓他們看到祂國度的能力和愛在萬族萬民中擴展。

走向更大的五旬節的應許

正如他們對五旬節的奇事感到驚訝，在五旬節之後，他們繼續為基督的榮耀和祂旨意的成就禱告。假如他們今天跟我們在一起，相信他們會祈求神以更偉大的方法，去把祂的聖靈澆灌出來，並大大使用祂的子民。

十天同心合意的禱告

世界各地的信徒，從 5 月 25 日（星期四）耶穌升天節開始，一直持續到 6 月 3 日（星期六），將會以各種方法組織起來，晝夜一同禱告。初期門徒「**同心合意的恆切禱告**」（使徒行傳 1:14），成為我們的榜樣和激勵。我們期望，在耶穌升天節與聖靈降臨節之間的十天，每一個時區每一個小時，都充滿信徒的禱告。下面的指引會翻譯成多種語言，以致世界各地數以百萬計的信徒，在這十天的禱告中，會有相同的聖經起始點。你不會獨自一人禱告的。

基督一再呼籲祂的教會同心禱告

震動世界的大災難驅使我們去禱告；更甚者，神精彩美好的應許，應該推動我們迫切熱烈地發出禱告。現在是時候了，神的子民要恆常地聚集在一起，在禱告中合一。我們把自己分別出來，用十天的時間尋求神，並以五旬節的高潮作結，正如耶穌初期的門徒所做的，有什麼方法比這更美好呢？

十天恆常禱告

5月25日至6月3日(10-1-90)

如何使用本禱告指引

1. 禱告要以聖經為根據

思想使徒行傳中的經文，怎樣為每天的禱告重點提供基礎，使我們能放膽禱告。例如：第六天的經文：「**因為這應許是給你們和你們的兒女.....**」（使徒行傳 2:39），就為神計劃為世界各地的年青人所做的，提供了支持和聯合禱告的重點。請你瀏覽 www.waymakers.org/tenday，查看每天經文的解釋和連結，你會找到更詳細的資料，知道每天的精選經文怎樣引導你禱告，並使聯合的禱告更有能力。

2. 禱告要具體

每天的主題只是提供一個起點，請你做一些調查，了解你身處社區的需要，列出相應具體的禱告要點。

聚集一起作特別禱告的方法

1. 找出具創意的聚集方式

數以百萬計的基督徒會以非凡的方式一起禱告。很多人會組成禱告鍊，或計劃長時間的聚會，使十天中每一天的 24 小時都充滿禱告。在這十天當中，找出具創意的方法，與其他人相聚在一起，作長時間的禱告。你可以：

- 一家人一起禱告，或在家中舉行小組禱告聚會。
- 開放教會的小型聚會給其他人參加，或計劃特別的禱告時段。
- 在會眾中組織特別的禱告音樂會。
- 在十天中，禁食一天或多天，甚至禁食十天。

- 在電話中與朋友一起禱告，或用電話會議禱告。
- 在這十天期間，很多人會在各個小時禱告。想知道有關 24 小時禱告的具意念，請瀏覽：

2. 聯合一致地禱告

在第一個的樓房禱告會中，門徒「同心合意」地禱告。你可以簡短的話語，為相似的主題，與其他的人一起同心地禱告，奮力向前。

3. 用不同的語言禱告

世界各地數以百萬計的基督徒，將會作出這些禱告。其他語言的禱文譯本，可以參考 www.globaldayofprayer.com。

4. 注意神可能會引導你的方法

當你為你的社區禱告時，神可能會感動你和其他人，以特別的方法，使你成為禱告蒙應允的部分答案。

第一天

5月25日（星期四）

基督的國度

——為基督國度的更新轉化能力禱告

[...講說神國的事。耶穌和他們聚集的時候，囑咐他們說：
『不要離開耶路撒冷，要等候父所應許的，就是你們聽見我
說過的...』]——使徒行傳 1:3-4

為祂的教會

- 求神使我們火熱愛主，忠於基督這位萬王之王、萬有之主。
- 求神感動我們，使我們在盼望中竭力追求主所應許的一切。
- 儘管神的子民分散各地，求神使他們藉基督再次聚集並順服祂。

為我們的世界

- 求神感動信徒的心，恆切禱告，祈求突破，叫神國度的祝福臨到那些面對重重困難的地方。
- 求神讓千千萬萬在我們城市中的人，經歷基督慈愛的美善和榮耀，藉此把持久的轉化帶進整個社區中。

第二天

5月26日（星期五）

聯合禱告運動

—— 為聯合禱告運動能持續下去禱告

[這些人...都同心合意地恆切禱告。] —— 使徒行傳 1:14

為祂的教會

- 求聖靈賜下代禱的靈，使我們心存期待、憐憫和盼望，持續地為神國度的應許得以成就禱告。
- 求神將我們聯合起來，「同心合意」地禱告；求神賜我們能力和熱心，為基督得榮耀和世人得憐憫禱告。

為我們的世界

- 求神感動在我們社區的人們去呼求神，尋求祂的幫助。
- 求神使社區的領袖仰望祂，在禱告中祈求祂的幫助。
- 願貧窮、年幼和社會邊緣群體，因禱告得蒙應允而獻上讚美，叫神得著榮耀。

第三天

5月27日（星期六）

基督的靈

—— 為神澆灌祂的靈在眾人身上禱告

[神說：在末後的日子，我要將我的靈澆灌凡有血氣的.....]

—— 使徒行傳 2:17

為祂的教會

- 求神的靈帶著能力和生命臨到基督徒。
- 求神的靈賜教會能力，在世上成為見證基督的僕人。

為我們的世界

- 求神的靈喚醒我們國家和社區裡所有人，使他們能聽見祂的聲音，看見祂的作為。
- 求神再次把祂的聖靈澆灌下來，使每一個人都能聽見祂的聲音，看見祂的作為（使徒行傳 2:33）。

第四天

5月28日（星期日）

悔改

—— 為多人離惡從善，得著在基督裡的新生命禱告

[所以，你們當悔改歸正，使你們的罪得以塗抹，這樣，那安舒的日子就必從主面前來到。]—— 使徒行傳 3:19

為祂的教會

- 求神叫我們看見自己的罪，公開承認我們怎樣叫神憂傷。
- 求神感動我們，使我們降伏在神的憐憫之下，以致我們的罪「**得以塗抹**」（使徒行傳 3:19）。
- 求神靠近祂的百姓，揭示祂的同在，使「**那安舒的日子**」（使徒行傳 3:19）來到，好像雨水降臨乾旱之地一樣。

為我們的世界

- 求神使基督徒領先轉離「**罪惡**」（使徒行傳 3:26），以致大規模的悔改運動席捲整個社區。
- 願千千萬萬的人遇見基督赦免的大愛，以致他們離棄罪惡跟從祂，得享救恩之樂。

第五天

5月29日（星期一）

基督的平安

—— 為人際關係得以更新轉化禱告

[信的人都在一處，凡物公用；並且賣了田產，家業，照各人所需用的分給各人。他們天天同心合意恆切地在殿裡，且在家中擘餅，存著歡喜、誠實的心用飯，讚美神，得眾民的喜愛。...] —— 使徒行傳 2:44-47

為祂的教會

- 求神使教會復和，除掉教會之間的分歧和敵視。
- 求神使祂的子民轉離貪婪和世俗的情慾，變成十分慷慨的人。
- 求神使基督徒之間的關係充滿愛、喜樂和歡欣。
- 求神賜教會在各社區中蒙恩。

為我們的世界

- 求神藉著祂子民生命的更新，讓全世界經歷祂所賜的平安。
- 求神醫治家庭中和鄰舍間的破碎關係。
- 求神介入戰爭，遏止邪惡的靈界勢力和恐怖主義，保護困苦人的生命。
- 求神使用基督徒幫助人脫離極端貧窮的壓制。（估計有超過十億人每天收入少於一美元，在貧困之中掙扎求存。）

第六天

5月30日（星期二）

新一代

—— 為神的旨意成就在家庭和兒童中禱告

[因為這應許是給你們和你們的兒女...] —— 使徒行傳 2:39

為祂的教會

- 求主基督鞏固婚姻關係和家庭制度。
- 願兒童和青少年從小就認識並跟隨基督，專心致志服侍祂。
- 求神叫年青領袖得著賞識，並能帶領教會倍增。
（使徒行傳 6:3-7）

為我們的世界

- 求神憐憫全球 1.2 億沒有機會接受教育的兒童，使他們能得到教育機會。
- 求神憐憫數以百萬計因戰爭或愛滋病失去父母的孤兒，叫祂的子民能因著神的愛，做到幼吾幼以及人之幼。（以目前的感染速度，預計到了 2010 年，全球將有 2,500 萬兒童的父母死於愛滋病。）
- 求神賜能力給新一代，在全地實現祂的應許。

第七天

5月31日（星期三）

神的呼召

——為萬國得聽見神的聲音禱告

[.....並一切在遠方的人，就是主我們神所召來的。]

——使徒行傳 2:39

為祂的教會

- 求聖靈充滿基督徒，使他們能有智慧並放膽傳講神的話語。
- 求神使祂的話語在各族、各民和各語言中被傳揚。
(使徒行傳 1:8)

為我們的世界

- 求神使世人能透過他們自己的語言和文化方式，聽聞祂「大能的作為」(使徒行傳 2:11)。
- 求神憐憫尚未有自己語言聖經的 3,000 個群體，願聖經早日翻譯成他們的語言。
- 很多未認識神的人居住在沒有活潑增長教會的地區，求神憐憫千千萬萬的未得之民，叫他們能跟隨基督。
- 求神召來並拯救許多求告祂名的人。(使徒行傳 2:39, 21)

第八天

6月1日（星期四）

主耶穌的榮耀

——為祂的子民有忠誠和勇氣榮耀主名禱告

[他們.....心裡歡喜，因被算是配為這名受辱。]

——使徒行傳 5:41

為祂的教會

- 求神幫助因耶穌的名被敵擋的人，使他們彰顯出耶穌的溫柔和剛強。（使徒行傳 4:13）
- 求神剛強為基督的名受苦的信徒，使他們滿有喜樂和信心。
- 求神在敵擋祂的地區中行奇事，並因此得榮耀。
（使徒行傳 4:21）

為我們的世界

- 求神賜福我們的政府和眾領袖。
- 求神賜智慧給那些敵擋基督的領袖（使徒行傳 4:25-27），使他們不再「攻擊神」（使徒行傳 5:39）。

第九天

6月2日（星期五）

基督的醫治

——為基督賜下實質的醫治禱告

[.....伸出你的手來醫治疾病，並且使神蹟奇事因著你聖僕耶穌的名行出來。]——使徒行傳 4:30

為祂的教會

- 求神在患病的人中間施行神蹟，醫治他們。
- 求神賜基督徒堅毅憐憫的心，致力消除疾病。
- 求神使信徒能夠在有極大需要的地方，提供基本的醫療服務。

為我們的世界

- 求神在我們這一代消滅愛滋病。（現時，每月有 250,000 個年輕人受感染。）
- 求神賜基本的醫療服務給最需要的人。（每天，全球有超過 30,000 名兒童死於可預防的疾病。）

第十天

6月3日（星期六）

基督的祝福

——為神應許的祝福臨到萬民禱告

[（神）對亞伯拉罕說：『地上萬族都要因你的後裔得福。』]

——使徒行傳 3:25

為祂的教會

- 求神使基督徒生活心存盼望，期待古老應許的祝福得以實現，看見國家社區被神更新轉化。
- 求神叫眾教會能同心通力合作，與神同工，使生命、城市、國家得著改變。

為我們的世界

- 求神的公義公平轉化商業和政治運作的方式，正本清源，糾正社會的歪風，使人們脫離貪污腐敗的咒詛。
- 求基督國度的和平，改變城市和國家的管治方式。
- 求基督生命中的喜樂，豐豐富富地臨到地上每一個族群。

A Global Day of Prayer

All together...in many places

“When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place.” – Acts 2:1

All together in many places.

As dawn broke on the first Pentecost, Christians were gathered “all together in one place” (Acts 2:1). On Pentecost, many millions of Christians will again be all together – but in many places. We’ll join together in prayers of blessing for the nations, praying in one accord for the biblical hope of Christ’s greater glory and the transformation of all nations.

Arising from Africa.

At the dawn of this century, a small band of believers gathered in Cape Town, South Africa, pouring out their hearts to God for their nation. A stadium full of 45,000 expectant people gathered in 2001 to seek God in repentance. God gave them a vision for a prayer movement that would soon sweep the continent of Africa. The next year that one gathering expanded to eight stadiums with 350,000 people, then jumped the following year to a staggering 2.5 million gathered in 130 stadiums. In 2004, the movement multiplied ten-fold, swelling to 22 million people gathered at more than 2,000 sites in every one of the 56 countries of Africa! That same year Africa invited the world to join them in the first Global Day for Prayer, which drew together an estimated 200 million people on May 15th, 2005.

10 Days - 1 Day - 90 Days (10 - 1 - 90)

With the Book of Acts as a model, we can find inspiration in the three parts to the birth of the Church: ten days of constant prayer leading to Pentecost, one day of prayer witnessed by the whole city, and days of blessing that followed. For these reasons, the Global Day of Prayer has three parts:

Ten days of constant prayer: May 25-June 3, 2006.

On Ascension Day, May 25th, millions of Christians will find ways to begin praying night and day throughout the ten days leading to Pentecost, following the pattern of Christ’s followers before the first Pentecost.

The Global Day of Prayer: June 4, 2006.

On Pentecost Sunday, Christians in almost every country will assemble to pray, many in homes and other public venues, many more in stadiums and open squares. Television, radio and internet will help to connect and align our prayers even more.

Ninety days of blessing: June 5 - September 2, 2006.

As in the first Pentecost, transformed Christians transform their communities, offering themselves to God as the instruments through which their prayers are answered. The Global Day of Prayer anticipates the forming or furthering of local alliances among pastors, congregations, mission agencies, business leaders, to bring practical, transformational blessing to their communities.

Why pray toward a greater Pentecost?

...For the Glory of Christ and the Transformation of Nations

On the last day He was with them, Jesus told His followers to stay in Jerusalem and to wait for "the promise of the Father." After Jesus was received into heaven, they gathered to do exactly what Jesus had told them: to wait for the promise of the Father. But they were praying for much more than a personal spiritual enrichment. Receiving God's Spirit was the beginning of all that God would do to finish everything He promised. They prayed in fervent, hope-filled passion for God to fulfill His promises regarding His kingdom all over the earth.

Hope-filled passion for God's promises.

As we read their prayers and listen to what poured out from their hearts in the days that followed Pentecost, we can get an idea of how they prayed during those ten days. They were praying far beyond their immediate concerns and personal problems. Their prayers sprang from the written Word of God. Christ Himself had ignited their hope with a renewed vision of the advance of the love and power of His kingdom among all peoples.

Toward the promise of a greater Pentecost.

As amazed as they were at the wonders of Pentecost, they kept on praying after Pentecost for Christ's glory and the fulfillment of His purpose. If they were with us today, they would likely be praying for God to pour out His Spirit and use His people in even greater ways.

Ten days uniting in prayer.

Beginning on Ascension Day, Thursday, May 25th, and continuing until Saturday, June 3rd, believers around the world will be organizing ways to pray together night and day. Inspired by the example of the first followers who “joined together constantly” in prayer (Acts 1:14), we expect that the ten days between the time of the ascent of Jesus and the descent of His Spirit will be filled with believers praying around the clock and across all time zones. The following prayer guide is being translated in many languages so that millions of people around the world will have the same biblical beginning points as they pray through these ten days. You won’t be praying alone.

Christ again calls His church to unite in prayer.

The great troubles that shake our world compel us to pray. But even more, the tremendous promises of God should move us to pray with urgency and desire. It is time for God’s people to gather again in persistent, united prayer. What better way is there than to consecrate ourselves to seek God for ten days, as Jesus’ first followers did, culminating on the day of Pentecost?

Ten Days of Constant Prayer

25 May - 3 June (10 - 1 - 90)

How to Use this Prayer Guide

1. Ground your prayers in Scripture.

Consider how the verses from the book of Acts provide a basis to pray with boldness for the daily prayer emphasis. For example, on Day 5, the scripture, “the promise is for you and your children...” gives support and focus for united prayer for what God intends to bring forth for young people all over the world. Check the biblical exposition and links for each day at www.waymakers.org/tenday. You’ll find more details about how each day’s scripture selection can guide and empower united prayer.

2. Make the prayers specific.

The daily topics provide a starting point. Do some research and make a list of specific prayer points which pertain to the people of your community.

Ways to Gather in Extraordinary Prayer

1. Find creative ways to gather.

Millions of Christians will be praying together in extraordinary ways. Many will form prayer chains or plan prolonged meetings which will fill 24 hours a day for ten days. Find creative ways during this ten-day period to gather with others to pray for extended times.

- Pray together as families or any small group meeting in your home.
- Leave church doors open for small gatherings, or plan special prayer times.
- Organize special concerts of prayer among congregations.
- Fast for one or more or all of the ten days.
- Pray over the telephone with a friend or set up a conference call to pray.

- Many will pray around the clock through the ten days. Find practical ideas about 24-hour prayer at www.24-7prayer.com, xtremepayer.com and www.globaldayofprayer.com/prayer.asp.

2. Pray unitedly.

At the first upper-room prayer meeting, they prayed with “one mind” or “one accord.” Pray in agreement with others by offering brief prayers that keep pressing forward on similar themes.

3. Pray with different languages.

Many millions of Christians the world over will be praying these prayers. See www.globaldayofprayer.com for translations available in a number of other languages.

4. Watch for ways God may guide you.

As you pray for your community, God may impress you and others with specific ways that He can use you to become part of the answer to your prayers.

Day ONE

May 25 Thursday

THE KINGDOM OF CHRIST

...For the transforming power of Christ's kingdom

"...and speaking of the things concerning the kingdom of God. Gathering them together, He commanded them not to leave Jerusalem, but to wait for what the Father had promised, 'Which,' He said, 'you heard of from Me...'" — Acts 1:3-4 (NASB)

For His Church

- For our hearts to blaze with love and loyalty to Christ as King and Lord of all.
- To be moved in hope so that we actively pursue all that He has promised.
- That however God's people may have been scattered and divided, we would be gathered again by Christ to obey Him.

For Our World

- For Christ to position believers in cities where breakthrough of blessing has not yet happened. Pray that they would patiently pursue God's promise of the blessing of His kingdom in those difficult places.
- For the goodness and glory of Christ's kingly love to be experienced by the masses in our cities, bringing lasting transformation throughout entire communities.

Day TWO

May 26 Friday

UNITED PRAYER

...For sustained movements of united prayer

“These all with one mind were continually devoting themselves to prayer...” — Acts 1:14 (NASB)

For His Church

- That God’s Spirit would give us a spirit of expectant intercession, compassion and hope to pray persistently for promises of His kingdom to be fulfilled.
- That God would unite us in prayer with “one mind,” empowering us to pray together with passion for Christ’s glory and compassion for the world.

For Our World

- That people throughout our communities would be moved to call out to God for His help as never before.
- That the leaders of our community would look to God for His help in prayer.
- That God would be glorified by the praises of the poor, the young, and the marginalized as He answers their prayers.

Day Three

May 27 Saturday

THE SPIRIT OF CHRIST

...For God to pour out His Spirit upon all

“‘In the last days,’ God says, ‘I will pour out my Spirit on all people...’” – Acts 2:17

For His Church

- For the Spirit of God to come upon Christians in powerful, life-giving ways.
- For the Church to be empowered by His Spirit to be Christ’s witnessing servants in the world.

For Our World

- That the Spirit of God would awaken people throughout our community and nation to hear His voice and to see His works.
- That once again, God would pour out from heaven that which everyone can “see and hear” (Acts 2:33).

Day Four

May 28 Sunday

REPENTANCE

...For many to turn from sin to new life in Christ

“Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord.”

— Acts 3:19

For His Church

- That we would recognize our sin and openly confess how we have grieved God.
- That we would be moved to fall upon God’s mercy for our sin to “be wiped out” (Acts 3:19).
- That God would draw near to His people, revealing His presence, bringing “times of refreshing” (Acts 3:19) like rain on dry ground.

For Our World

- That Christians would be the first to turn “from their wicked ways” (Acts 3:26) so that massive movements of repentance would sweep through whole communities.
- For Christ to encounter millions of people with His forgiving love, so that they turn from their sin to the joy of following Him.

Day Five

May 29 Monday

THE PEACE OF CHRIST

...For relationships to be transformed

“All the believers were together and had everything in common. Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need... They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people...” — Acts 2:44-47

For His Church

- For reconciliation among churches, removing divisions and hostilities.
- For God’s people to turn away from greed and worldly desires and to become more generous than ever before.
- For relationships among Christians to be marked by love, joy and gladness of heart.
- For churches to enjoy renewed favour in every community.

For Our World

For Our World

- For the righteousness and justice of God to transform the ways of commerce and politics, cleansing whole societies from the curse of corruption.

- For the joy of Christ’s life to flourish throughout every people group on earth.
